## Where are we staying?

We are staying at the Wymah Valley Resort at Bowma, NSW.  
This is about 25km north of Albury off the Hume Hwy.  
The resort is set well back from the highway and quiet - apart from us...

Those of you who went to the last 'Lager Frenzy' will remember it as the  
"Great Aussie Resort"

There is a pool, tennis court and most importantly a sandpit.

## Meals

Dinner on Saturday and Sunday night will be included. It will be spit roast buffet style,  
with dessert.

A continental breakfast will be included for the Sunday Morning – 3 cereals, toast,  
juice, fruit, tea and coffee.

Monday morning we will be leaving about 8.30am and travelling as a group to the  
Beechworth Bakery for breakfast before the trip home.

## Activities

Being just north of Albury allows several possibilities, but mainly these:

- Riding east to Corryong and the Snowy Mountains along the border
- Heading south to Yackandandah, Beechworth, Bright or Mount Beauty and surrounds if you like crafty shops, boutique cafes and wineries.
- And of course stay by the pool and do nothing - if you're that way inclined.

## How will we get there?
