Accommodation

We are staying at the Porepункah Pines Tourist Resort (www.porepункahresort.com.au) in various sized cabins. There is a pool, it is near the river and has a very relaxed atmosphere. Linen is supplied.

Activities

As with bright, Porepункah is near to wineries, boutique towns like Beechworth and the crafty Yackandandah. There are plenty of places to go for a ride too, if you wish. As usual you can always just stay and do nothing or lounge near the pool - if you're that way inclined.



The Cost

The cost is \$45 per head for all adults per night.

Included in the price is:

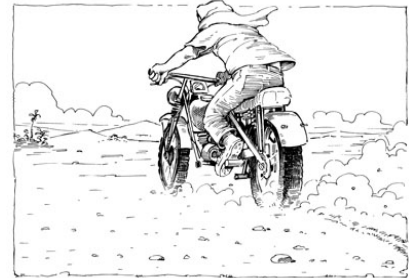
- **2 Nights accommodation**
